Unlike a traditional divan with small drawers built into the sides, an ottoman divan gives you access to the whole area underneath every inch of the base becomes usable storage. Once you're finished, the base lowers back down gently under its own controlled resistance rather than slamming shut. It's a mechanism built for daily use, and a well engineered gaslift is one of the clearest signs of a quality ottoman divan bed versus a budget imitation. 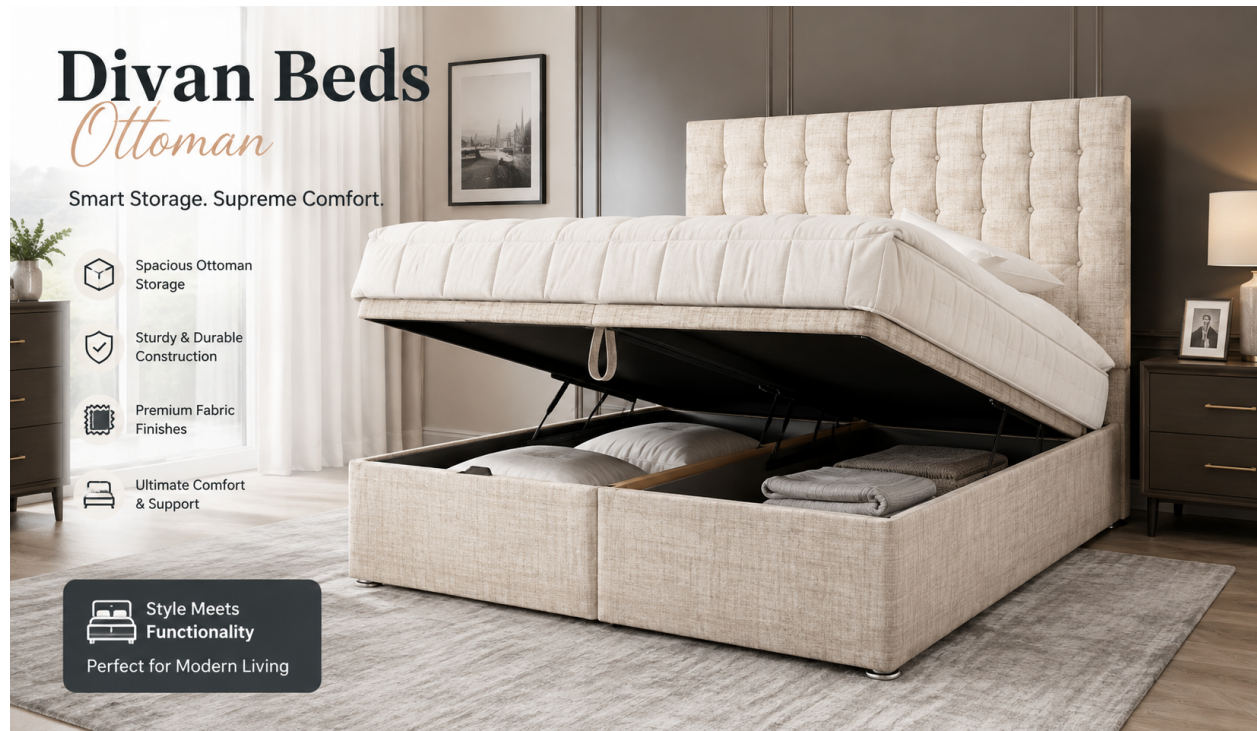
